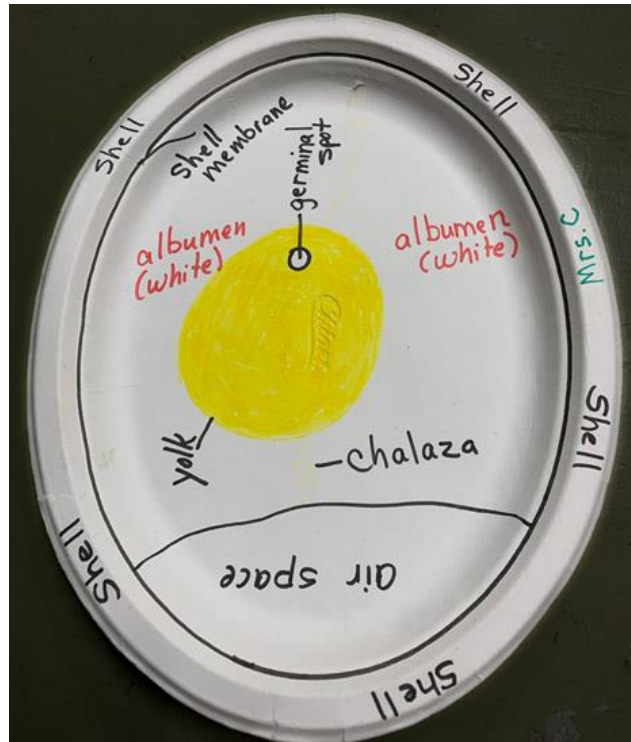


# Parts of an Egg Diagram



## Materials

- Oval Paper plates (or cut a round paper plate into an oval or just draw an oval on a plain white piece of paper)
- Yellow & black marker, colored pencils or crayons

## Directions:

1. Look at the egg diagram in the IL Poultry Ag Mag (page 2) or the sample picture above:

2. Draw your own diagram:
  - a. Draw the oval & label the shell
  - b. Draw & label the air space/air cell at one end
  - c. Draw a Yellow circle & label it "Yolk"
  - d. Draw a Black circle inside the yolk & label it the "Germinal Spot"
  - e. Label the white space around the yolk "Albumen"
  - f. Draw the twisted strands from the yolk to the top & bottom of the shell and label them "Chalaza"
