\_\_\_ Spaghetti sauce

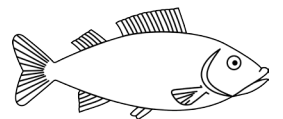
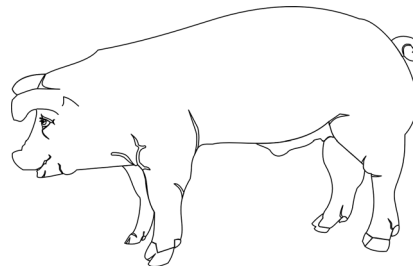
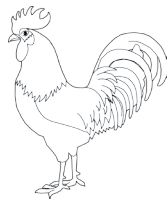

## In the Fridge or Freezer

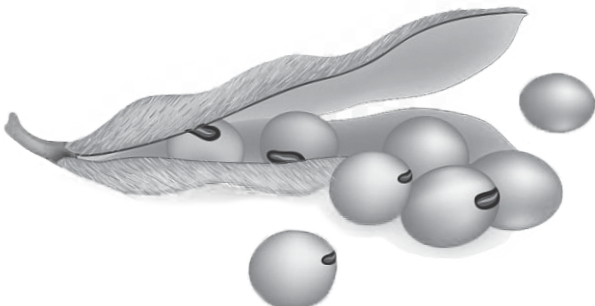
\_\_\_ Chicken

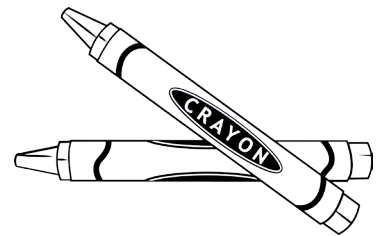


Soybeans provide feed for chickens, pigs & farm-raised fish!
